## Dear Fellow Dairymen,

Indian Dairy Association (South Zone) has immense pleasure in inviting you for the 46<sup>th</sup> Annual Dairy Industry Conference (DIC) to be held at Angamaly, Kochi, Kerala from 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> February 2018.

India retains first position in milk production since last two decades and the per capita milk availability is above the requirement prescribed by medical authorities indicating that we have reached milk sufficiency. This conference would facilitate debates on strategies to achieve efficiency as per the specified standards in Indian dairy sector.

The 46<sup>th</sup> DIC will provide an exciting opportunity to all the participants to interact, learn, share and link with fellow dairymen. The participants will get a chance to present their research findings and views that could contribute to the sustained efficiency of dairy sector. It aims to highlight the technological developments in various dairy and allied fields; milk production, processing, packaging, manufacture of milk products, waste management and energy conservation etc. The conference also envisages drawing a road map for the sustainable growth of dairy sector with inputs from dairy farmers, scientists, industries and all other stakeholders.

The concurrent Dairy Expo will showcase technological developments in milk production, processing, feed and fodder, packaging, product manufacture, energy conservation and so on. An expressive e-Poster Session, with latest research findings, would also feature at the Conference.

It may be mentioned that the Dairy Industry Conference has been held twice earlier at Kerala — during 1971 and 1988. The organizers will be putting their best efforts in making the event a memorable one. A pleasant stay at God's own country is assured.
